Cheri - I am a rider on a Dyna Low-Rider.

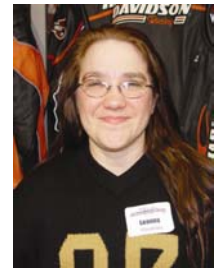
Jenny - I am a Sportster Rider.
